8. To review, discuss and act on acquisitions or needed repairs to the District's equipment, vehicles or apparatus.
9. To review, discuss and act on construction, improvements or repairs to the District's stations or related facilities.
10. To review, discuss and act on matters related to operation and construction of dispatch center.

To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.071 to consult with legal counsel regarding pending or contemplated litigation, settlement offers or on matters which require confidentiality under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas and Tax Code §323.3022 to discuss sales tax matters.
12. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.072 to deliberate regarding real estate matters.
13. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.074 to discuss personnel matters.
14. To act on matters discussed in closed session.
15. To discuss and take action to confirm the next regular monthly meeting date as well as any items that need to be on the next meeting agenda.
