10. To receive an operations and financial report from Community Volunteer Fire Department, and to take any necessary action thereon, including to receive and approve the Department payroll and expense totals from the previous month and Department budget.
11. To review, discuss and act on matters related to operation of Westcom.
12. To review, discuss and act on matters related to Public Information Request processes and methods of receipt.
13. To review, discuss and act on matters related to District's website, social media and public education.
14. To review and act on disposal of surplus equipment.
15. To review, discuss and act on acquisitions or needed repairs of District supplies, equipment, vehicles or apparatus, including funding.
16. To review, discuss and act on needed improvements or repairs to the District's facilities, including funding.
17. To review, discuss and take action on matters related to construction (current and proposed) projects, including funding.
18. To review, discuss and take action regarding real estate matters.
19. To review, discuss and take action on matters related to personnel, including compensation, benefits, retention and recruiting.

To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.071 to consult with legal counsel regarding pending or contemplated litigation, settlement offers or on matters which require confidentiality under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas and Tax Code §323.3022 to discuss sales tax matters.
21. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.072 to deliberate regarding real estate matters.
22. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.074 to discuss personnel matters.
23. To take action on matters discussed in closed session.
24. To discuss and take action to confirm the next regular monthly meeting date as well as any items that need to be on the next meeting agenda.
